Section 2.04 - Promotions

- (d) The City retains the right to hire the City Clerk and Fire Chief through advertisement and acceptance of applications, of which, bargaining unit employees shall have the right to apply for. Additionally, the Assistant Fire Chief position is voluntary in nature and is completely at the discretionary appointment of the City.

The Parties agree to amend Article IV, Section 4.01 with the following addition of the classification of Fire Chief into the wage schedule and the amended language in the third paragraph of the Section following the wage table:


The Fire Chief must possess current, legal, verified Firefighter I and Firefighter II certification.



ORDINANCE NO. 1107

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF MINER, SCOTT COUNTY, MISSOURI, TO AMEND THE CURRENT CONTRACT WITH THE INTERNATIONAL BROTHERHOOD OF ELECTRICAL WORKERS, LOCAL UNION NO. 702, PERTAINING TO ARTICLE II, SECTION 2.04 - PROMOTIONS, AND ARTICLE IV, SECTION 4.01 - CLASSIFICATION AND RATES OF PAY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMAN OF THE CITY OF MINER, SCOTT COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:


- SECTION ONE: The Mayor and Board of Alderman do hereby amend the current collective bargaining agreement with the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local No. 702, specifically the "City Employees" Agreement should and if a full time Fire Chief is hired; and
- SECTION TWO: Attached hereto, marked "Exhibit A" and incorporated by specific reference thereto as if fully set out is a copy of the revised language which shall be recognized by the Parties concerning Article II, Section 2.04 - Promotions, and Article IV, Section 4.01 - Classification and Rates of Pay, of the aforementioned collective bargaining agreement.
- SECTION THREE: Any and/or all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
- SECTION FOUR: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

Read this first, second and third time this 28th day of April, 2015.
